HALLBROOKE CLUBHOUSE / POOL RULES

POOL HOURS: Tuesday - Sunday: 6:00 - 8:00 am - adults only & 10:00 am - 10:00 pm- all.

- A. All swimming is done **AT YOUR OWN RISK.** There is no Lifeguard. Solo swimming is prohibited.
- B. You may use your key to let in family members or your invited guests only. Once inside the clubhouse/ pool area, **DO NOT LET IN ANYONE** other than a family member or an invited guest. You may not let in any other homeowner who has "forgotten their key".
- C. A maximum of 4 guests (non Hallbrooke / Hall Park 7 residents) allowed per household, except for reserved parties. (see reservation policies)
 The Hallbrooke / Hall Park 7 member must be present with their guests.
- D. **NO** alcoholic beverages may be brought inside the fenced area **AT ANY TIME** due to liability issues. For safety reasons we strongly suggest that no alcoholic beverages be consumed less than one hour before swimming.
- E. All family members and/or guests under the age of 12 **MUST** be supervised by an adult at all times inside the fenced area.
- F. **No** pets are allowed inside the clubhouse / pool facility.
- G. All swimmers should shower before entering the pool.
- H. **NO** running, rough play or horse-play will be tolerated at any time inside the clubhouse / pool facility.
- I. **NO SMOKING** will be tolerated in the pool or pool area.
- J **NO** eating or drinking will be allowed in the pool. Food and beverages must be kept in the covered area of the pool grounds. Homeowners will be responsible physically or financially for keeping the pool and pool area clean.
- K **NO** glass containers will be allowed anywhere within the fenced pool area.
- L. **NO** Skateboards allowed on the clubhouse property.
- M. All trash must be disposed of properly.
- N. Swimmers **must be dry** before entering the clubhouse (except for direct entry to the bathrooms).
- O. Please keep the bathrooms as clean as possible. They are there for your convenience. If there is a lack of supplies in the bathroom, please contact Aria Real Estate Group at (405)701-8881.
 - If there is an emergency at the pool concerning pool equipment or the pool itself, please call Eric McMurray at 210-8114.
- P. Observe the campers # 1 rule. "Always leave it cleaner than you found it".
- Q. If the fenced pool area is locked during regular hours, do not enter the pool area.

The Hallbrooke Pool is viewed by the State as a public pool and undergoes random inspections by both State and County Health Departments. Any violation of the above rules may cause the pool to be shut down temporarily until corrections are made.

The clubhouse / pool area has security cameras that are video monitored. Destruction / Vandalism may result in the loss of privileges and financial reimbursement.
